



2022 Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) and Electronic Scrap (E-Scrap) Collection Schedule

- Manatee County residents may drop off (HHW) and (E-Scrap) for FREE at the Lena Rd Landfill.
- For diesel fuel & gasoline if it gets drop off during the week Mon. to Fri. there is no vendor on site and your container will not be returned to you. For the 3rd Saturday a vendor will be on site and your container can be returned to you.
- The Lena Rd Landfill will be closed on the following holidays: **New Year's Day, President's Day, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.**

- The Lena Rd Landfill is accepting (HHW) Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. and every 3rd Saturday of the month from 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m., from residents only.
- (E-Scrap) can be dropped off Monday through Saturday from 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
