



## PUBLIC NOTICE

### PROPOSED TRAFFIC REGULATION

Pursuant to Code of Ordinance of the City of Palmetto Article II Section 28 – TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES the Public Works Department is proposing to install three (3) new ALL-WAY Stop signs at the intersection at 13<sup>th</sup> St. West, 12<sup>th</sup> St. West and 31<sup>st</sup> Ave. West (please see attached map).

This regulation has been posted on the community board at City Hall and on the City's Web Page ([palmettofl.org](http://palmettofl.org)) for a minimum of (7) seven days prior to the Regular City Commission Meeting scheduled for April 18, 2016 at 7:00 p.m., and shall become effective following the meeting unless it is called up for consideration by (2) two members of the City Commission.

Written comments filed at City Hall will be heard and considered. If any person desires to appeal any decision of the City Commission or any other Board of the City, that person will need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based. (F.S. 286.0105).
