



2023 Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) and Electronic Scrap (E-Scrap) Collection Schedule

- Manatee County residents may drop off (HHW) and (E-Scrap) for FREE at the Lena Rd Landfill.
- For diesel fuel & gasoline, if it is brought during the week Mon. to Fri. there is no vendor on site and your container will not be returned to you. For the 3rd Saturday a vendor will be on site and your container can be returned to you.
- The Lena Rd Landfill will be closed on the following holidays: **New Year's Day, President's Day, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.**

- The Lena Rd Landfill is accepting (HHW) Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. and every 3rd Saturday of the month from 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m., from residents only.
- (E-Scrap) can be dropped off Monday through Saturday from 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
